- → Dates-birth, baptism, marriage, military, death
- ✔ Places-province, county, region, country
- → Relatives-father, mother, sister, brother, aunt

Additional Info:

- Other family members
- ✓ Friends & neighbors
- Family stories and traditions
- Religion

DECIDE WHAT YOU WANT TO LEARN

Primary goal:

- → Find immigrant's place of origin
- ✓ If you don't have enough information to determine this then choose secondary goal that will lead you to the primary goal.

Secondary goals:

- Date of immigration
- ✓ Place of departure
- Place of arrival
- Ship's name and related data
- Names of other immigrants in the group
- Immigrant's original country or region
- Immigrant's name before immigrating
